Committee Descriptions on Page 2

Committee Job Descriptions

Affiliate Committee: Any Affiliate member who would like to support the Real Estate Industry and the Realtor Membership. The Chairperson of the Affiliate Committee Serves as a voting Director on the Board of Directors for 2 year term. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson.

Community Service: To promote the positive Realtor image in the community. Assist in planning functions for the FAOR Charitable Foundation. Each County has its own Foundation representatives. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson. (Main event is the Reverse Raffle/Cook off)

Continuing Education: This Committee works with office staff to schedule classes offering interesting and exciting education to area Realtors, at reasonable fees, while financially supporting its own programs. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson.

Diversity & Equal Opportunity in Housing Committee: Studies ways and determines means to assist Members and our communities in celebrating the differences of cultural diversities. This committee also raises member and public awareness of rights and **responsibilities of equal opportunity in housing**. Host at least one event during the year.

FAOR Charitable Foundation: Committee consists of Officers and Members and is our 501(c)3 non-profit organization. This committee oversees the disbursement of contributions to local non-profit organizations in the 5 counties we service. Each County has its own Foundation representatives. The committee works with the Community Service Committee to organize and plan yearly events to raise money. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson.

Forms: Assist staff by keeping the MLS forms used by FAOR up to date and relevant for the members of the Association. Committee meets when necessary to go over changes to MLS Forms.

Golf Outing: Help plan and organize the annual Bob Strayer Memorial Classic. Meets only for planning and organizing of the Golf outing. (Usually only 3 or 4 meetings)

Legislative: To keep abreast of legislative issues as well as encourage members to be an active participant in the RPAC campaign. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson

RPAC Fundraising: Encourage members to be an active participant in the RPAC Campaign. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson.

Member Services and Awards: Plans the Annual Banquet and picks the Award recipients. Accept nominations and distribute annual awards including Rookie of the Year, Affiliate of the Year, Hall of Fame, etc., as well as Service Awards. Plans the Annual Banquet. Starts to meet mid-year.

MLS Research Committee: Agent led research at the discretion of the MLS Broker Committee. Committee meets as determined by the Chairperson and the MLS Broker Committee requests.

MLS Brokers: Must be FAOR & MLS Broker Member or Managing Licensee. Assist staff and members by offering ideas and suggestions to help make the MLS more user friendly. Discuss MLS updates and possible MLS issues. Direct MLS Research Committee. Committee meets Monthly if there are agenda items. This committee meeting can be done by Zoom or in person.

Scholarship: Awarding scholarship funds to adult students who are pursuing a career in Real Estate. Two scholarships by The CE Shop are given per year (1 – Pre Licensing & 1 – Post License). Committee meets 1-3 times to review the application and determine the scholarship recipients.
